OVERVIEW

We begin Lead NJ's Issue Seminar year by looking at the State Budget. Here in a single document are contained our public policy priorities, addressing every facet of governmental responsibilities, programs, mandates and opportunities, from state to county to municipal jurisdictions, and legislative, executive, and judicial branches.
