The Seminar on Environmental Policy will take place in the Pine Barrens on Friday, September 11, 2020. We will convene on at 9:00 AM at the headquarters of the Pinelands Preservation Alliance, 17 Pemberton Road, Southampton.

We will depart by car for Pinelands Adventures for lunch and be transported by buses (socially-distanced, maximum of 10 people per bus, wearing masks and with windows open) to the put-in point for our canoe trip down the Mullica River. We will conclude the canoe trip around 3:30pm and be bused back to Pinelands Adventures to adjourn.

This month's discussions and site visits will expose you to many sides of environmental policy including land preservation, the balance between human use and environmental conservation, green building design, and other key topics.

**Attire: we will be both in canoes and taking nature walks in the Pinelands for much of the afternoon, we encourage you to dress casually and be prepared to get wet! Shorts, t-shirts, water shoes, etc. are appropriate.**
