RE: Seminar on Education, May 16 – 17, 2019

On Thursday May 16th and Friday May 17th, we will convene in Newark for our Seminar on Education.

Over our two days together, we will hear from educators in K-12 and higher education institutions about education in Newark and across the state. We will meet public school officials, public charter school innovators, and private school administrators. We will receive briefings on Newark's school reform, and hear from experts on college and workforce readiness. And we will explore what exactly it means to be an educated person in our ever-changing democratic and economic environment, presented by one of the visionary leaders in the field of teacher preparation. We will also spend some time preparing for your class meeting in July and reviewing LNJ's Leadership In Action program and some of the successful individual projects that have taken place in recent years.

We will cover a lot of ground together. Our suggested preparatory readings for this Seminar necessarily present a wide range of topics to help inform our discussions. Please take the time to familiarize yourselves with these as the information they contain provides a common ground from which our deliberations spring.
